- 8:05am Warm up done
- 8:20am **Wind Ensemble** performance
- 8:30am **Bus #2 and #3** arrive in Pleasanton at Amador Valley High School. Juice and muffins provided by Boosters. Everyone change into marching band uniform.
- 9:15am Drumline warm-up
- 9:45am Drumline warm-up ends. **MAKE SURE ALL THE NECESSARY EQUIPMENT IS LOADED ON THE GOLF TRAILER.**
- 9:55am Report to section leaders to warm up and tune.
- 10:40am Report to formation
- 11:20am Inspection
- 11:30am Competition step-off
- 11:38am Percussion step-off
- 12:00pm Report to buses. Load equipment and depart for Foothill High School.
- 12:40pm Change into street clothes and band t-shirt. Eat lunch. You may bring a lunch or purchase at Foothill High School concessions.
- 1:50 pm Awards, sit together, **wear your band t-shirt**.
- 3:00 pm Awards are over, stay together in our group for announcements and presentation of awards by the awards line, go immediately to bus area.
- 3:30 pm Load buses, depart for FHS.
- 5:00 pm Arrive FHS, put away all equipment and instruments, and go home.
