- 7:00 am** **Meet at the band room. Don't forget your marching shoes and accessories.**
- 7:30 am Depart for Petaluma
- 8:45 am Arrive at Petaluma. Dismissal in order to get uniforms.
- 9:45 am Warm up with sectional leaders and tuning.
- 10:40 am Report to Formation area
- 10:45 am Inspection
- 10:50 am Step off from inspection into formal warm up.
- 11:00 am Competition step-off
- 11:10 am Percussion step-off. **MAKE SURE ALL NECESSARY EQUIPMENT IS LOADED ON THE GOLF TRAILER.**
- 11:20 am Done Marching. Change immediately into street clothes with **Scarlet Brigade T shirt** and return your uniform for inspection before hanging it up on the rack.
All instruments need to be packed and loaded before leaving for lunch. Go get lunch – **DO NOT LEAVE CAMPUS.** You may bring a lunch if you wish. Most bus drivers do not allow eating and drinking on the bus. Please abide by the rules.
- 1:30 pm Report to stadium for awards. Sit as a group and represent your school appropriately. **SHOW YOUR SCARLET BRIGADE PRIDE.**
- 3:15 pm Awards are completed. Load the busses and depart for home.
- 4:45 pm Arrive back at Fairfield High School. Unload trucks and put away equipment properly. Have a good rest of the weekend.

IMPORTANT NOTES:

Band and pageantry members must ride the bus to and from the review. If you have a legitimate reason for leaving the review early, Mr. Taylor must have a signed Band Student Release Form by 3:00 pm Friday. Forms are available in the Band Room office. Notes received on the day of the review will not be honored, no matter what the reason. If Mr. Taylor excuses a student to leave early, it will be only to a parent or guardian, not a sibling. Any parents driving must follow the last bus. Do not drive between the busses. Maps will be ready on Friday.

Band members are expected to dress in a reasonable manner following band performances. This includes wearing of the **CURRENT OFFICIAL SCARLET BRIGADE BAND T-SHIRT.** School dress code is applicable to band functions. Band t-shirts are to be worn properly at all times, head and arms in proper holes, no stomachs showing, the shirt must be completely on.
