

Scarlet Brigade Parents:

Chaperones are needed for various band activities throughout the year.

To chaperone band activities, band reviews, band trips, jazz trips and winterguard and winter percussion activities you MUST:

- Attend our mandatory training on Monday, September 11th, at 7pm in the band room.
- Have cleared fingerprints with FSUSD. FSUSD AR 1240 reads "All volunteers who have direct contact with students, and are not under the direct supervision of a certificated employee, must be fingerprinted." Call 421-4001 to schedule an appointment. There is a fee. You must have a valid CA Driver's License.
- Fill out a volunteer agreement with FHS Principal's Secretary in the front office after your fingerprints clear.
- Chaperone a minimum of 3 fall marching band reviews.

If you plan to be a carpool driver for Pipe Band, Jazz Band, Drumline or Winterguard, fill out a Driver's form and DMV Pull Notice with FHS Principal's Secretary in the front office. You are required to provide a copy of the front and back of your driver's license and a copy of your auto insurance policy with bodily injury coverage in the amount of at least \$100,000/\$300,000 and property damage liability in the amount of at least \$50,000.

Once you are fingerprinted, your cleared prints are valid at any FSUSD school for as long as you wish to volunteer. You must fill out a new Volunteer Agreement with the school each fall.
