

Road Crew Information

The Road Crew helps us drive equipment to band reviews, band trips, jazz trips, winter guard and winter percussion activities. If you would like to be part of the Road Crew you MUST:

- Attend our mandatory training on Monday, September 11th, at 7pm in the band room.
- Must be at least 25 years old to drive
- Have cleared fingerprints with FSUSD. Call 421-4001 to schedule an appointment.

There is a fee. You must have a valid CA Driver's License.

- Fill out a volunteer agreement with FHS Principal's Secretary in front office after your fingerprints clear.
- You must have completed the driver's training workshop with Mr. Fisher prior to driving one of our vehicles.

If you are driving any district owned equipment (band trucks) you must file a DMV Pull Notice Form for District Transportation to check your driving record. This form is available through Mrs. Rummel in the band room office.

If you plan to be a carpool driver for Pipe Band, Jazz Band, Drum line or Winter guard, fill out a "use of private vehicles for transporting minor and adult students on school sponsored events" form with FHS Principal's Secretary in the front office. You are required to provide a copy of the front and back of your driver's license and a copy of your auto insurance policy with bodily injury coverage in the amount of at least \$100,000/\$300,000 and property damage liability in the amount of at least \$50,000.

Once you are fingerprinted, your cleared prints are valid at any FSUSD school for as long as you wish to volunteer. You must fill out a new Volunteer Agreement with the school each fall.
